On August 29, 1821, members of the Chippewa, Ottawa, and Potawatomi signed a treaty with the United States of America, ceding 4 million acres of land in southwestern Michigan to the United States, including the land now known as Coldwater, MI. On June 19th, 1832 the Methodist Episcopal Church was established in Coldwater with 5 pioneering members, the first church in the newly formed city. This church met in Rev. Allan Tibbits log cabin until 1836-1838 when the first Methodist Episcopal Church was built in Coldwater. During this time, from 1838-1840 the Potawatomi Indians of Branch Co (and SW MI) were forcibly relocated from their ancestral lands to reservations in Iowa, Kansas, and Oklahoma. This forced march was known as the "Trail of Death", a 660-mile forced march at gun point that killed at least 42 people, including 28 children. They died mostly from starvation and exhaustion. In the month of January 2025, our church will consider the harm done to our Potawatomi siblings through a worship series and study centered on the 1st Biblical exile from Jerusalem experienced by the Jewish people as seen in Jeremiah, 2nd Kings and Daniel and how it relates to the forced march known at the "Trail of Death".
