
# Sunday, May 7, 2023 **Coldwater United Methodist** 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter

"Thus it is, that in the children of God, repentance and faith exactly answer each other. By repentance we feel the sin remaining in our hearts and cleaving to our words and actions: by faith, we receive the power of God in Christ, purifying our hearts, and cleansing our hands.
